In relation to Cookies while browsing

The cookie (or computer cookie) is a small information sent by a website and stored in the user's browser, so that the website can consult the user's previous activity.

		used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data and to track site usage for the site analytics report. Cookies store information anonymously and assign a randomly generated number to identify unique visitors.	
_gat	Statistics	These cookies are installed by Google Universal Analytics to restrict the percentage of applications in order to limit the collection of data in areas of high traffic.	1 minute
_gid	Statistics	This cookie is installed by Google Analytics. The cookie is used to aggregate information about how visitors use a website and helps create an analytical report on website performance. The data collected includes the number of visitors, the source from which they came and the pages visited anonymously.	1 day
